Under the supervision of the Director of Fisheries and his/her coordinator, the Officer will ensure the proper management of FSC fisheries through his/her supervision and technical work.

- Prepare and release cages and catch lobster
- Actively participate in the maintenance, repairs and storage of the boat and equipment
- Various other tasks on the boat
