

The Nation Micmac de Gespeg is looking for a fisher helper for the 2024 season to join the crew on a lobster boat operating a community commercial licence in the St-Georges-de-Malbaie area. Under the supervision of the Director of Fisheries and the Captain, the selected person will be required to participate in all required tasks on a fishing vessel.

Key responsibilities of the fisher helper

- · Arrive on time for all fishing departures
- Prepare and release cages and catch lobster
- Actively participate in the maintenance, repairs and storage of the boat and equipment
- · Various other tasks on the boat

Requirements

- Any fishing experience that includes trap fishing will be considered
- Marine Emergency Function (MED), Marine First Aid and other Transport Canada requirements will be considered assets
- Attendance and punctuality
- Good mood and ability to work in a team

- Excellent physical condition and ability to work long hours in harsh weather conditions
- Not to suffer from seasickness
- Be able to drive or be driven to the harbour
